**Meeting Minutes**

Number of Members in attendance: 16

Dave Halt, Chair of the CFDTC, convened the meeting at 7:35 p.m.

1. The minutes of the Committee Meeting at the FEDSM 06 in Miami, FL were unanimously approved.
2. Chair presented announcements from the EC/TC Chairs' meeting:
  - a. Current meeting IMECE06 has about 3000 registrants.
  - b. Next FEDSM in 2007 will be in San Diego, CA with George Papadopoulos as Chair. It will be a joint meeting with JSME. Advance registration cost will be \$495 and student registration is reduced to \$145 to encourage student participation.
  - c. The November meeting which has been called IMECE is undergoing significant change. This is currently a very large meeting and it will be broken into two parts: 1) The technical part will remain in the Nov meeting and is currently planned to be called IMERIC, International Mechanical Engineering Research and Innovation Conference. 2) The non-technical or administrative part will be moved to the summer ASME meeting, not to be confused with the separate summer Fluids meeting. Calls for papers at IMERIC will transition to multi-disciplinary topics where the co-organizers would need to be from more than one division. One of the goals is to reduce the size of the conference to four days, Monday-Thursday and hopefully reduce cost to the registrants. Any feedback on the IMERIC plans and proposed multi-disciplinary topics should be given to Urmila Ghia within the next couple of weeks.
  - d. Jim Liburdy will be chair of FEDSM08 meeting in late July 2008. Bids are going out in Boston, MA. We plan to join with heat transfer, advanced energy systems and nano-technology divisions for this conference.
3. The call for papers “Symposium on Uncertainty in Large-Eddy Simulations” was approved for FEDSM08 to be sponsored by CFDTC. There was discussion on whether it was appropriate to attempt to determine uncertainty standards in a fledgling technology such as LES. There were suggested edits to the organizer’s call for papers. Another call for papers was approved for IMECE07 which has the lead sponsor of FMTC and is now co-sponsored by CFDTC.
4. Adiel Guinzburg, chair of honors and awards committee asked for session organizers to submit candidate papers for Knapp and Moody awards.

5. Joe Katz, Editor of JFE reports that the journal is flourishing. Numbers of submissions and articles published have increased considerably. The journal will go to a monthly publication in 2007.
