

Meeting Minutes - K-16 COMMITTEE ON HEAT TRANSFER IN ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT
IMECE2010, Vancouver, Canada
Tuesday, Nov. 16, 12:00-1:00

1. Self-introduction of attending K-16 committee members
2. Minutes from K-16 meeting at 2010 ITherm Conference approved
3. Update on IMECE 2010 by Shirish Mulay, KCR.
 - The K-16 sponsored sessions received 36 abstracts, 4 were rejected and 20 final papers were submitted and accepted. We held a total of 4 sessions, with 5 papers in each session. All sessions will be tomorrow. The paper process ran smoothly overall and co-KCR Mark Kimber was a big help. Mark will serve as KCR for IMECE 2011 (Denver). A co-KCR is needed.
 - The conference meeting schedule has been problematic with many meetings changing day and time at the last minute, causing people to miss the meetings.
 - It was noted that the website program was not searchable, leading to difficulties finding sessions.
4. Update, 2011 Heat Transfer Division 2011 ASME/JSME AJTEC Conference, March 13-17, 2011, Honolulu, HI .
 - No organizers for this conference were in attendance. Several attendees had reviewed papers for it.
5. Update, 2011 InterPACK, Portland Oregon, July 6-8.
 - It was noted that abstracts are due Dec 15th, full papers due January 25th.
 - Gamal is working on the tutorials and looking for industry sponsors.
6. Report on Journal of Electronic Packaging sent by Bahgat Sammakia, highlights included:
 - Total page allocation maintained at 500 pages/year
 - JEP Total Review Process Time for 2009/10 was 16.0 weeks
 - Median Time to Publish (from submittal) for 2010 was 48.2 weeks
 - Paper acceptance rate was 43% for 2009-2010 papers
 - Paper submittal to JEP increased 20%* over 2009 submittals
 - 2009 JEP Impact Factor = 0.781
 - Added seven new Guest Editors
 - 2010 JEP Associate Editor of Year Award to Gamal Refai-Ahmed
 - 2010 JEP Best Paper of Year award to Cheng-Hung Huang and Wei-Lun Chang
7. NEW BUSINESS
 - There is a call for nominations for election for a new Recording Secretary to begin serving in July 2011. At that time, Gamal Refai-Ahmed will become K-16 chair and Sam Graham, Vice-chair. By convention, the nominee must be from Industry.
