



A. Taner Derbentli was born in Muş, Turkey in 1948. He obtained his B.Sc (ME) and M.Sc(ME) degrees from the University of Manitoba in Winnipeg, Canada. He did his Ph. D. studies in the İstanbul Technical University in the area of radiative heat transfer in absorbing and emitting media, receiving his degree in 1980.

Dr. Derbentli has been a faculty member of the Department of Mechanical Engineering of the İstanbul Technical University since 1983 as assistant, associate and full professor.
