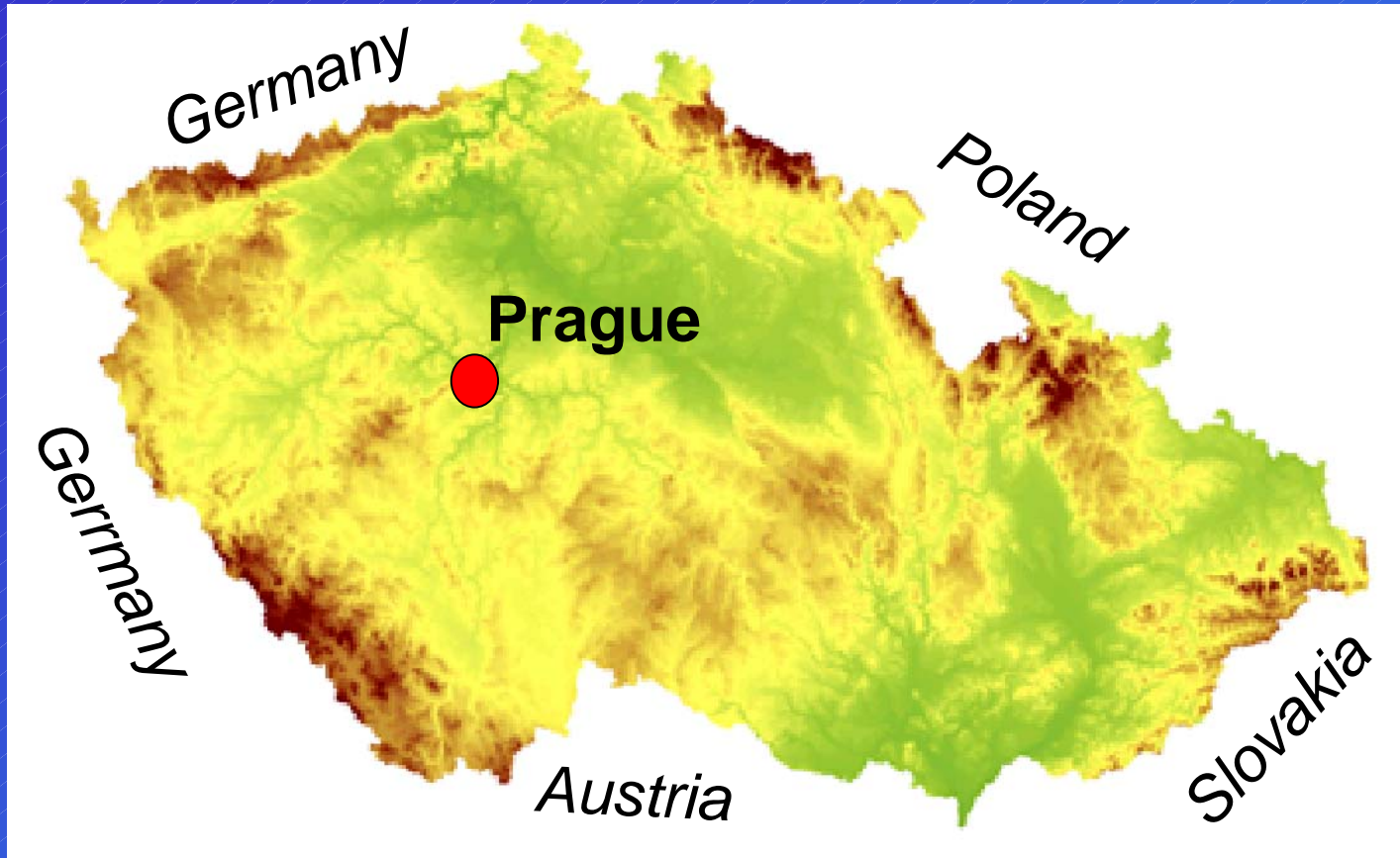

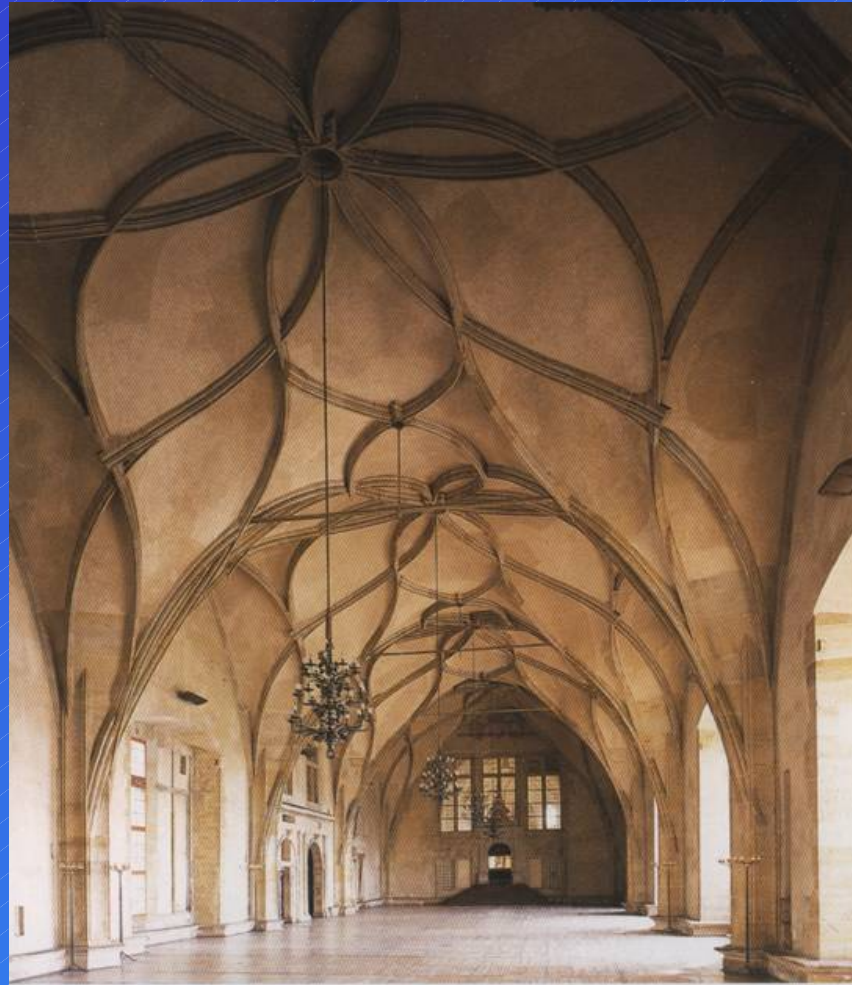
St. Vitus Cathedral

Jewish Quarter

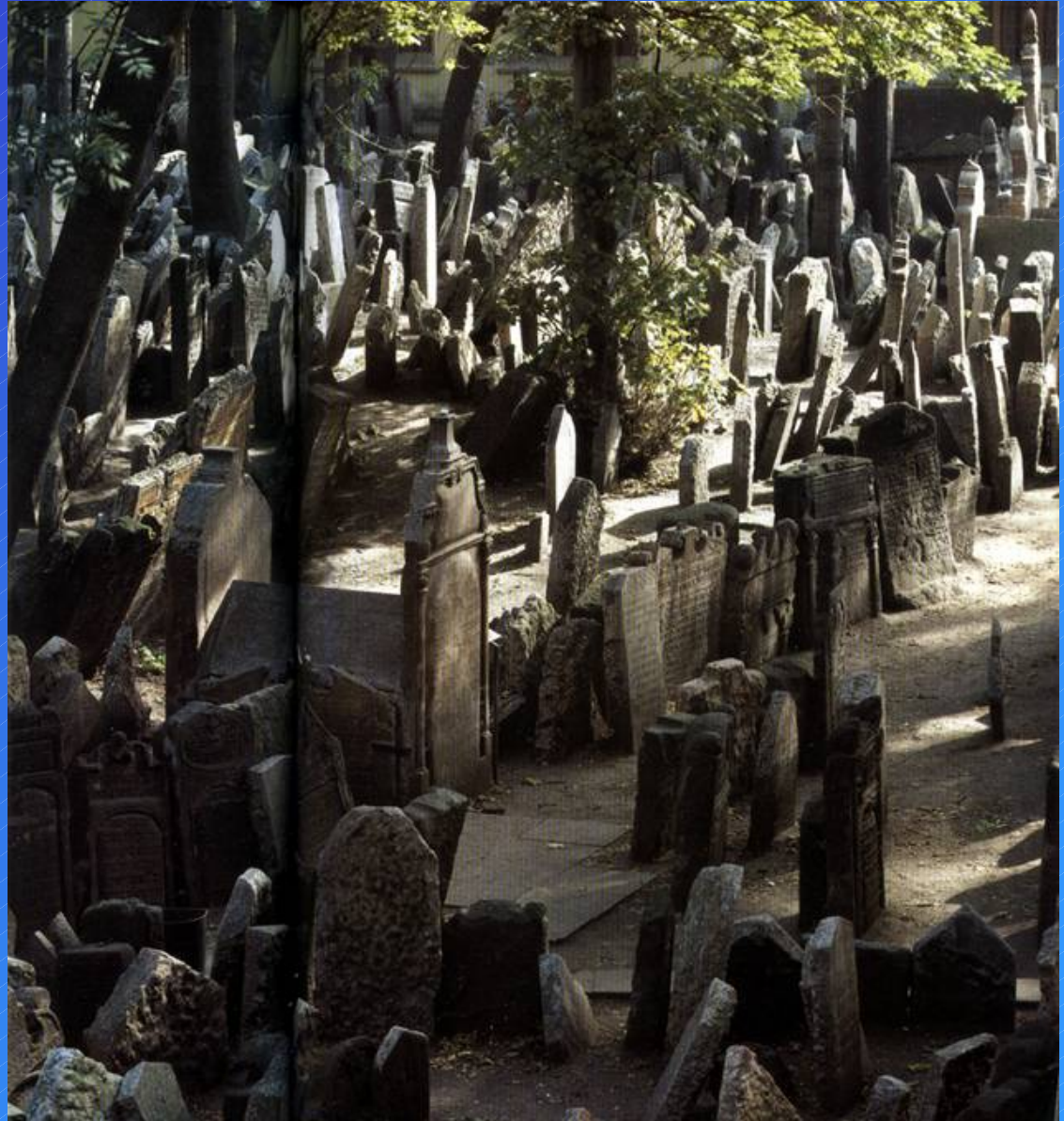
The oldest preserved synagogue in the Central Europe. It was built in the early gothic style in the late 13th century
