Corrosion is the deterioration of a material due to a reaction with its environment. From underground water pipes to airplanes to oilfield equipment, corrosion is an undeniable force in our world today. In 1998, metallic corrosion cost the United States approximately \$276 billion, or 3.1% of GDP. It is estimated that one-third of this cost is preventable with the application of current corrosion control technologies.
