Technical Communities

- Technical Group Leaders communicate and advocate for the technical divisions
- Each group leader has an operating board of technical division chairs and members at large
- These technical groups existed previously and their role has been reemphasized
- Performance Criteria of a healthy technical division demonstrated through Plan and Report cycle by each Technical Division chair and incoming chair in the Group Operating Boards

Purpose of Technical Group Leader (see Op Guide Appendix)

- Primary Mission is to guide the technical divisions, provide performance criteria, review performance, compare approaches, share ideas, help identify customers
- Primary Work Load will be raising the division issues and problems until they are resolved
- The Technical Group Leaders will interact with all 5 VP's

Issues

- Division Revenues and control of earnings after expenses

- Board on Research and Technology Development should not be a revenue neutral entity and the reduction in subsidy is too steep

Power and Money
