TCOB Conferences Committee.

Each Group Should Have a Conferences Committee, composed of the division conferences chairs

Group 1 Conferences Committee.
Members: chairs of conference committees of Divisions A and B

Group 2 Conferences Committee.
Members: chairs of conference committees of Divisions C and D

Each Division Should Have a Conferences Committee, even if only one member.

Members of each service committee are chairs of the corresponding committees one level lower.
