

## 8. Revisions

Each Nominating Committee may amend, revise, or replace this manual subject to the provisions of the Constitution and By-Laws and Society Policies (see Appendix C). This action is usually taken at the Interim Meeting.

"Each year, not later than February 1, the Nominating Committee shall submit any proposed changes to Manual MM-10 to the Committee on Organization and Rules for review and recommendation."

The Manual Review Subcommittee shall submit revisions to the Committee after the Interim Meeting. Action at this meeting shall be taken to either approve the revisions in principle and specify what further steps shall be taken for final approval, decide to operate under the current Manual without revision, or take any combination of these steps.

A revision shall be tentatively operative as soon as approved, but any actions taken are subject to reconsideration if the revision is found to be inconsistent with the Constitution and By-Laws or Society Policies.
