Dr. Laura Wojcik is a Senior Director with Packer Engineering in Ann Arbor, Michigan, where she is a consultant in the areas of biomechanics and mechanical engineering. Prior to joining Packer, Dr. Wojcik worked for Exponent, Inc. and for the Department of Engineering Science and Mechanics at Virginia Tech, where she performed research in musculoskeletal biomechanics and taught undergraduate and graduate courses in mechanical and biomedical engineering as an Assistant Professor. Before her faculty appointment, Dr. Wojcik was a Whitaker Fellow and a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at the University of Michigan.

She earned her Ph.D. and M.S.E. in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Michigan and a B.S. in Mechanical Engineering from Michigan State University, where she was an Alumni Distinguished Scholar and a member of the Honors College. Dr. Wojcik is also a licensed Professional Engineer and has participated in professional workshops including the NAE's Frontiers of Engineering Symposium, the Summer Institute on Aging Research sponsored by NIH and the Brookdale Foundation, and the Catalyst Workshop at AFI.
